Notification of filming at the Little River Mechanics Institute Hall, Little River

To the Residents,

My name is Drew Rhodes and I am a Location Manager currently working on an HBO television series entitled "The Leftovers".

About the series:

The Leftovers (Series 3) is an eight part drama television series that tells the story of the sudden disappearance of 2% of the world's population, without a trace and with no explanation. It follows the stories of those who are left behind as they search for meaning and in this third and final series, the search for answers leads to Australia. Filming will take place in Melbourne and Broken Hill, NSW from late June through to October 2016.

Location:

We are planning to film scenes for the series at the **Little River Mechanics Institute Hall**, Rothwell Road, Little River

Filming Date:

Filming is scheduled to take place on **Friday 15th July from 4:00pm to 8:00pm**

Scenes:

The dialogue scenes to be filmed on Friday will take place inside the hall, which will be dressed as a mock police station.

Pre Dressing / Rigging and Filming:

There will be a smaller team of crew members in place from Monday 11th July to pre-dress and pre-rig some sets and equipment into place from approx. 8.00am on each day. **Before and during the filming on Friday, there will be a large number of crew and crew vehicles in place around the hall.** Our On-Set Location Manager, **Julian Duggan (M) 0407 471 501** will be onsite to oversee the filming and liaise as required. We will endeavour to ensure that any disruption is kept to an absolute minimum. You will, however, notice increased activity in the area.

Parking and Traffic Control:

We will have a large number of trucks and production vehicles parked in the nearby streets surrounding the Mechanics Hall, **in reserved spaces in River Street, Rothwell Road and Flinders Street (around the Possy Newland Reserve)**. Our Unit Base (for catering, Make-Up, Wardrobe and Greenrooms etc.) will be parked near the Little River Railway Station. Complete Traffic Management will be employed to reserve parking in the area and provide traffic control, security and pedestrian management around the site during filming to ensure safe access for the public and residents. **Please liaise with the security guard if you have any concerns or specific requirements about the parking arrangements. We will happily assist anyone who contacts us!* The production has been coordinated with, and received assistance from, all relevant bodies including the City of Wyndham and Film Victoria.
